HONORING CHAIR LEON GARCIA FOR 22 YEARS OF EXEMPLARY SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP

WHEREAS, Chair Leon Garcia has dedicated 22 years of outstanding service to the American Canyon Fire Protection District with 19 of those years serving as the Chair of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, Chair Garcia has been instrumental in guiding the District through critical projects, important initiatives, and unprecedented challenges, always maintain a focus on the safety, wellbeing, and progress of the community; and

WHEREAS, During his tenure, Chair Garcia has provided exceptional leadership in the following significant accomplishments:

In 2002-2003:

- Established an aerial fee for structures over three stories, addressing the needs of taller buildings within the District;
- Secured property for the future Public Safety Facility, ensuring the growth and preparedness of the District.

In 2005-2006:

- Approved the construction of a new Fire Station at 911 Donaldson Way, enhancing emergency response capabilities.

In 2008:

- Adopted the 2009-2013 Strategic Plan, setting a clear course for the District's development;

In 2009:

- Adopted the District's Emergency Operations Plan, strengthening readiness for all hazards.

In 2010:

- Approved a Vesting Resolution, ensuring legal protections for the District;
- Executed a Joint Agreement between the City of Napa Fire Department and the American Canyon Fire Protection District to enhance regional collaboration;
- Secured the purchase of life-saving EKG equipment.

In 2012:

- Established a fee schedule for recovering the costs of fire prevention services;
- Acquired a new water tender and Engine E1-1, improving the District's firefighting capabilities.

In 2013:

- Approved crucial amendments to the Fire Code.

In 2014

- On March 1, 2014, a significant milestone was reached as the American Canyon Fire Protection District, in partnership with American Medical Response, approved an agreement establishing the Emergency Ambulance Services and Advanced Life Support System. This collaboration marked a pivotal step in enhancing emergency medical response and life support services for the community.

In 2016:

- Authorized the purchase of a replacement Type 6 apparatus, enhancing the District's operational fleet.

In 2017:

- Re-adopted the Emergency Operations Plan and implemented a Fund Balance/Reserve Policy to ensure the District's fiscal stability.

In 2019:

- Approved a lease option and agreement to purchase land, ensuring the future expansion of District facilities.

In 2020:

- Guided the District through the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic;
- Approved the opening of a second fire station, expanding service to the community;
- Facilitated the appointment of Interim Fire Chief Michael P. Cahill;
- Secured the AFG Grant for essential SCBA equipment.

In 2021:

- Approved the Long-Range Master Plan, charting the District's future;
- Authorized the creation of two Battalion Chief positions to meet growing operational demands.

In 2022:

- Approved the appointment of Geoff Belyea as Fire Chief;
- Finalized the Enterprise Fleet Lease agreement;
- Approved the Lease/Purchase agreement for two new Type 1 fire engines.
- Authorized a Memorandum of Understanding with Buzz Oats.

In 2023:

- Supported the purchase of Motorola Radios;
- Established the Firefighter/Paramedic Trainee position;
- Secured multiple grants, including the OTS Grant for extrication equipment, Boating and Waterway Grant for a rescue boat, Firehouse Grant for protective turnouts, and a regional grant partnership with County Fire Agencies;
- Adopted the development impact fee nexus study, implementing a fire capital facilities fee to support future infrastructure.

In 2024:

- Approved the formation of a Community Facilities District (CFD) for portions of Watson Ranch, ensuring sustainable growth;
- Secured another OTS Grant for extrication equipment;
- Finalized the Air Ambulance Agreement with REACH Air Medical Services to enhance emergency medical transport capabilities.

The Fire District recently hosted a successful Open House event featuring demonstrations on extrication equipment, fire extinguisher use, and hands-only CPR training. Notably, Napa County surpasses the national average for cardiac arrest survival rates, a testament to our community's dedication to emergency readiness. Our colleagues from the American Canyon Police Department also participated, presenting a canine demonstration.

He recognized two Probationary Firefighters, Mr. Cummings and Mr. del Castillo, who successfully completed Module 2 of their probationary testing.

Looking ahead, the District will host a safe trick-or-treating event open to the public, in partnership with the American Canyon Police Department. This event aims to provide a safe, enjoyable Halloween experience for families in our community.

Lastly, he extended gratitude to the Board for their ongoing support and for approving our new agreement with REACH Air Medical Services, which includes our partnership with Copter 11. This agreement is a valuable addition to our emergency response capabilities.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS

In 2008, the City of American Canyon Governance Protocol Handbook was updated, adding a Fire District Board meeting on the fifth Tuesday of the month when there is a fifth Tuesday, in which the District Board conducts a standalone, non-joint meeting from the American Canyon City Council in order to focus on District-related items. (Section V 4.1.1. Meetings). Until a comprehensive revision is done to the Governance Handbook, the City Council of the City of American Canyon sitting ex officio as the Board of Directors for the American Canyon Fire Protection District (“District”) approved Resolution 2021-14 on June 29, 2021, establishing a monthly stand-alone, non-joint meeting date to focus on District issues. The Board of Directors shall meet every fourth Tuesday.

In accordance with this section, the Board of Directors may consider an annual meeting calendar. The proposed calendar outlines the 4th Tuesdays for the year 2025, with an exception for the months of November and December. In light of the 4th Tuesday coinciding with Thanksgiving week in November, the Staff proposes a change of the meeting to the 2nd Tuesday of that month, November 11, 2025. Consequently, it is recommended to reschedule the regular meeting to the second week of November, and to cancel the regular meeting originally scheduled for December 23, 2025.

Adoption of a Calendar of Regular Meetings does not prevent the Fire District Board from calling additional special meetings throughout the year or cancelling meetings when necessary.
