4. Minutes

5. Old Business

a. Mural for Museum of Art Downtown: Artist Selection

Staff presented the top artists for the Museum of Art’s downtown location mural, and the Committee recommends the selection of CJ Hungerman’s “We Rise” mural proposal for the project.

b. Hydrant Painting Project: Location Selection

Staff recommended moving this item to the October Meeting Agenda.

c. Cornerstone Development Mural: Budget Approval

Staff proposed a request from Cornerstone Development for a contribution to their mural by Sonny Behan, in the amount of \$30,000. These funds will be used toward the 1,460

square feet of the mural which are visible from the public sidewalk and qualify as public artwork. The Public Art Committee recommends the approval of this project and the proposed contribution from the Public Art Fund.

d. Cosmological *Principal* Repairs

Staff presented information on the total spent to date on the sculpture *Cosmological Principle*, as well as the cost to restore the sculpture. The required restorations, priced at \$11,400, would cost more than the combined cost of the initial purchase price and all previous restoration attempts totaling \$10,066.25. Based on this information, the Committee has decided to deaccession of *Cosmological Principle* from the Public Art Collection. City Staff will proceed with beginning the deaccession process and will notify the artist.
