Public Comment

- Items on the agenda: Members of the public wishing to speak on an agenda item may come forward when called by the Board President at the time the Board considers that item.
- Items NOT on the agenda: Members of the public wishing to address the Board regarding items not on the agenda may do so during the Item **Public Comment on Non-Agendized Items** (Regular Board Meetings only).

As a reminder, Board rules and California law does not allow the Board to take action or to discuss any item not explicitly posted on the agenda in advance.

Speakers will queue behind the podium and state their name and city prior to speaking; speakers will have three minutes at the podium and may not yield their time to another speaker; total public input on any one agenda item will be limited to twenty minutes (This time may be extended at the discretion of the Board President); if there are still speakers after twenty minutes they may submit their comments to the Board in writing at kmcelligott@coronadousd.net. Comments submitted electronically will be shared with all Trustees and posted with the meeting minutes.

Disturbances

The Board president shall not permit any disturbance or willful interruption of Board meetings. Persistent disruption by an individual or group shall be grounds for the chair to terminate the privilege of addressing the Board.

Public Records/Brown Act

In compliance with Government Code section 54957.5, non-exempt writings that are distributed to a majority or all of the Board of Trustees in advance of its meetings, may be viewed at the Coronado Unified School District located at 201 Sixth Street, Coronado, California 92118. In addition, if you would like a copy of any record related to an item on the agenda, please contact the Superintendent's Office at 619-522-8900. Also, in accordance with the Brown Act, all public Board meeting recordings are available for review on the district website.

Upon request by a student's parent/guardian, or by the student, 18 or older, the minutes shall not include the student's or parent/guardian's address, telephone number, date of birth, or email address, or the student's name or other directory information as defined in Education Code 49061. The request to exclude such information shall be made in writing to the Executive Assistant to the Superintendent and Board of Trustees (Education Code 49073.2).
