**BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:**

The Pacheco Storm Water District's Board of Trustees has two seats with terms expiring on December 5, 2025, currently held by Trustees Armando Alfaro and Paula Azcona. Pursuant to the Storm Water District Act of 1909 and applicable sections of the California Elections Code, the District must hold a general election to fill these expiring terms. While the Board previously reviewed and adopted a similar resolution, subsequent review by the Elections Department identified necessary revisions to align the resolution language and procedures fully with election requirements. Therefore, the Board is revisiting and approving this revised resolution, which formally calls for the election to be held on July 29, 2025. This updated resolution includes precise details on candidate statements, nomination filing timelines, public notifications, and explicitly requests election management services from the San Benito County and Santa Clara County Elections Departments. Approval of this corrected resolution is required to proceed accurately with election preparations.

## Resolution No. 2025-\_\_\_

### Resolution Ordering an Election, Requesting County Elections to Conduct the Election, and Requesting Consolidation of the Election

#### Pacheco Storm Water District

**WHEREAS**, Pacheco Storm Water District ("District") is a stormwater district organized and operating under the Storm Water District Act of 1909 with a board consisting of up to five (5) trustees elected by landowners of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms of two trustees of the District, namely, Trustees Armando Alfaro and Paula Azcona, will expire at 12:00 PM on Friday, December 5, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10002, the city or district shall reimburse the county in full for the services performed upon presentation of a bill to the city or district; and

**WHEREAS**, for the purpose of filling said offices, it is necessary that a Storm Water District general election be held pursuant to the Storm Water District Act of 1909, and other pertinent laws of the State of California;

#### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. An election of the District be held pursuant to applicable sections of the Storm Water District Act of 1909 and Sections 10500, et seq., of the California Elections Code.
2. The two seats vacated by Trustees Armando Alfaro and Paula Azcona, whose terms expire on December 5, 2025, will be filled by qualified candidates elected by the landowner voters of the Pacheco Storm Water District.
3. In accordance with Section 13307 of the California Elections Code, the candidates are to pay for the publication of their statements of qualifications; candidates shall be allowed to submit a Candidate's Statement of Qualifications consisting of not more than 200 words; and no additional mailing of candidates' materials will be authorized by this governing body pursuant to Section 13307 of the California Elections Code.
4. The Secretary of this Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to Section 10509 of the California Elections Code, to notify by a Notice, the Registrar of Voters of San Benito County and the Santa Clara County Elections Department on or before the 125th day prior to said election, that there are two elective offices to be filled at the District general election for the Pacheco Storm Water District's Board of Trustees, to be held on July 29, 2025, and that each candidate will pay for publication of their Statement of Qualifications.
5. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10510, the period for filing nomination documents by candidates in this District election shall commence on the 113th day prior to the election. The nomination documents shall be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., on the 88th day prior to the election in the office of the appropriate officer during regular office hours.
6. The Elections Department of San Benito County is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to Section 12112 of the California Elections Code, not less than 90 days but not more than 120 days prior to the day fixed for said election, to publish at least once in newspapers of general circulation in the District in San Benito and Santa Clara Counties, a Notice stating the date of the election and the number of offices to be filled at said election, namely two members of the Board of Trustees of the Pacheco Storm Water District.

7. The Secretary of this Board of Trustees shall designate the Registrar of Voters or their designee to act in their place and stead in issuing Official Filing Petitions and administering oaths or affirmations as required under Section 10512 of the California Elections Code and Article XX, Section 3 of the California Constitution.
8. The Secretary or any officer of this Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions that may be necessary or appropriate; including procurement of necessary supplies and services to prepare for and conduct said general election.
