**5.A RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY - S. LOUPE, PUBLIC WORKS
ADMINISTRATOR- Presentation by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers**

The District Flood Risk Program Manager from the Army Corps of Engineers provided an overview of their technical assistance programs, which support communities with flood risk management, aquatic ecosystem restoration, and navigation. The presentation covered the streamlined process for requesting assistance, with typical projects taking 12 to 18 months and costing around \$150,000. Examples of past projects, such as flood risk mapping and emergency action planning, were shared. The Corps encouraged the district to submit a request letter and assured ongoing support despite current federal budget delays.

5.B RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY - S. LOUPE, PUBLIC WORKS

ADMINISTRATOR- Update regarding debris removal and levee repair

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer provided an update on debris removal and levee repair. FEMA confirmed that the reimbursement request could proceed while the final burn site remained pending, with all required materials submitted. Efforts to coordinate with Cal Fire for the remaining burn pile were ongoing. For levee repairs, additional information was provided to the Army Corps of Engineers to determine jurisdiction. A geotechnical engineer proposed a cost-effective solution for reinforcing the embankment on the Florex property, with the contract routed for approval. The project was expected to move forward once the contract was signed and further site evaluations were conducted.

ADMINISTRATOR- Update on status of FEMA applications

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer provided an update on debris removal and levee repair. FEMA cleared the environmental review stage for debris removal, allowing the project application review team to assess all submitted information before moving to the reimbursement phase. For levee repairs, the project advanced to the final FEMA review of all documents, including contracts and invoices. Since both projects are individually under \$1 million, FEMA can approve reimbursement and initiate funding while the projects are ongoing. The levee repair application remained ahead of the debris removal process, with progress made on both fronts over the past month.

5.D RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY - S. LOUPE, PUBLIC WORKS ADMINISTRATOR- Discuss process of obtaining maintenance agreement with California Fish and Wildlife

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer, provided an update on the process of obtaining a maintenance agreement with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. He contacted two environmental firms, Denise Duffy & Associates and H.R.V., which have experience working with the county. Although response delays occurred due to the holiday season, the county requested that a biologist or project manager present an overview of the maintenance agreement process through the Lake and Streambed Alteration Program at the next meeting, scheduled for January 27th. The trustees were reminded to consider whether the agreement should be for five years or more, with the presenting expert expected to outline the pros and cons of each option. Loupe expressed optimism that at least one of the firms would be available to provide the presentation.

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer, provided an update on the drone footage request for assessing debris removal needs. He reported that Bryce, a local overseer of the area, confirmed that the request was placed in their queue. The planned drone survey will cover the stretch from downstream of the Lovers Lane Bridge up to slightly beyond the county limits. Although no specific timeframe was provided, Loupe assured that once the county receives the footage, it will be uploaded to Dropbox and shared with the trustees for review. The footage will help determine whether investing \$13,000 per week for cleanup is justified. Additionally, trustees suggested sharing the footage with the California Conservation Corps to assess their potential involvement, which Loupe agreed to consider after initial trustee review.

The Trustees discussed potential grant opportunities, focusing on the Riverine Stewardship Program managed by the California Department of Water Resources. The program's Urban Streams Restoration initiative, which funds projects like stream cleanups and bank stabilization, requires a 20% match. Trustees considered seeking assistance from the Army Corps of Engineers for project planning before applying and discussed the possibility of hiring a grant writer to manage the application process.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Pacheco Storm Water District (PSWD) has historically operated without formally adopted bylaws. Recently, the need to establish clear governance procedures became a priority due to upcoming election requirements. The district's election is scheduled for the last Tuesday in July of every odd-numbered year, and in order to proceed with the election in a structured and legally sound manner, bylaws must be in place.

Through coordination with the San Benito County Elections Office, it was determined that formal bylaws would provide necessary clarity on election procedures, board composition, and operational guidelines. The proposed bylaws define:

- The structure of the Board of Trustees, including roles, responsibilities, and election procedures.
- The timing and process for district elections, ensuring compliance with state election laws.
- How meetings will be conducted, including regular and special meeting procedures.
-

- Compliance with the Ralph M. Brown Act to maintain transparency in decision-making.

By adopting these bylaws, the district will establish a **clear framework** for its governance and ensure that future elections and operations are conducted in a consistent and compliant manner.

The Board of Trustees is now being asked to **review and formally adopt** these bylaws through the attached resolution.

A RESOLUTION OF THE PACHECO STORM WATER DISTRICT ADOPTING BYLAWS FOR THE GOVERNANCE AND OPERATION OF THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS the Pacheco Storm Water District (“District”) recognizes the need to establish formal bylaws to provide clear guidelines regarding its governance structure, roles, responsibilities, and procedures; and

WHEREAS the adoption of bylaws will promote transparency, accountability, and efficiency in the District’s operations and decision-making process; and

WHEREAS the District’s Board of Trustees has reviewed and discussed the proposed bylaws, attached as **Exhibit A**, which set forth provisions related to board meetings, officer duties and terms, elections, decision-making procedures, and other operational matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pacheco Storm Water District that the Board of Trustees hereby adopts the bylaws attached as **Exhibit A** to govern the operations and procedures of the Pacheco Storm Water District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board and its members shall adhere to the provisions outlined in the adopted bylaws, and these bylaws shall be referenced as the guiding document for governance matters.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any amendments or modifications to these bylaws shall require by approval a majority vote of the Board at a duly noticed meeting.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

EXHIBIT A

BY-LAWS: Pacheco Storm Water District

PACHECO STORM WATER DISTRICT BY-LAWS Procedures for the Transaction of Business

I. Name

The name of the district shall be the **Pacheco Storm Water District** (hereinafter referred to as "District").

II. Purpose

The District is established pursuant to the **Storm Water District Act of 1909** to:

1. Maintain, improve, and manage stormwater infrastructure within its jurisdiction.
2. Implement storm water control measures, including regulating the maintenance of waters of any unnavigable stream, water course, canyon, or wash within the District.
3. Secure and manage funding for stormwater and flood control projects.
4. Comply with state and federal regulations concerning water management and environmental protection.

III. Governing Board

A. Board Composition

The District shall be governed by a Board of Trustees ("Board") consisting of three (3) members, elected at-large from among qualified landowners within the District. The Board shall elect from among its members a President, who shall preside over meetings and serve as the primary representative of the District. The selection of the Chairperson shall take place at the first meeting following each election and shall be determined by a majority vote of the Board.

B. Powers and Duties

The Board of Trustees shall:

1. Supervise and manage all District affairs, property, and funds.
2. Establish rules and regulations for stormwater management and flood control.
3. Enter into contracts and agreements necessary for District operations.
4. Levy and collect fees and assessments as authorized by law.
5. Oversee compliance with the **Storm Water District Act of 1909** and other applicable laws.
6. Monitor proper maintenance and operation of storm water infrastructure within the District's jurisdiction.

C. Term of Office

1. Trustees shall serve staggered **four-year terms**.
2. At the first election after the Board is reactivated, **two (2) members** shall serve **two-year terms**, and **one (1) member** shall serve a **four-year term**, determined by agreement or by lot.
3. Successor trustees shall be elected to full **four-year terms**.

IV. Elections

A. Election Procedure

1. Trustees shall be elected **by landowner vote**, in accordance with **California Elections Code Section 10500 et seq.**
2. Elections shall be conducted **by mail ballot**, administered by the San Benito County Elections Office.
3. The **election date shall be the last Tuesday of July of every odd-numbered year.**
4. Only qualified landowners within the District may vote, with voting power proportionate to the assessed value of their landholdings, as required by the **Storm Water District Act of 1909.**
5. If the number of nominees does not exceed the number of open seats, the **San Benito County Board of Supervisors** may appoint the candidates **in lieu of an election** in accordance with **California Elections Code Section 10515.**

B. Candidate Nomination

1. Candidates must be **landowners** within the District and must have **resided within the District for at least one (1) year.**
2. Nomination petitions must be filed with the **San Benito County Elections Office** within the legally prescribed filing period.
3. If a vacancy occurs on the Board mid-term, the **remaining trustees may appoint a replacement**, subject to confirmation by the San Benito County Board of Supervisors.

C. Assumption of Office

1. Elected Trustees shall assume office **at noon on the first Friday in December** following the general election.
2. Appointed Trustees shall assume office **upon taking the oath of office.**

V. Meetings

A. Regular and Special Meetings

1. The Board shall hold **regular meetings on the fourth Monday of every month** at a designated location within the District.
2. Special meetings may be called as necessary by the **President** or by a written order of the majority of Trustees, provided any Trustee not joining in the order is given at least **two (2) days' notice**.
3. All meetings shall comply with the **Ralph M. Brown Act (California Government Code Section 54950 et seq.)**, ensuring public access and transparency.

B. Quorum and Voting

1. A **quorum** shall consist of a **majority (two members) of the Board**.
2. A majority vote of the Trustees present shall be required to adopt any motion, resolution, or policy.

VI. Conflict of Interest

1. Trustees must disclose **any financial interest** in matters before the Board and shall recuse themselves when necessary.
2. The Board shall comply with the **California Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000 et seq.)** regarding financial disclosures.

VII. Amendments

1. Amendments to these Bylaws may be made by a **majority vote of the Board of Trustees** at a regularly scheduled meeting.
