**5.A RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY - S. LOUPE, PUBLIC WORKS
ADMINISTRATOR- Adopt resolution calling for district election/ discuss
election process**

Victor Tafoya, associate planner, presented information regarding two trustee terms expiring on December 5, 2025, currently held by Trustees Alfaro and Azcona. A revised election resolution was discussed, detailing candidate terms, statements, filing timelines, and election management services. Ana from the San Benito County Elections Department provided a detailed explanation of election processes, candidacy filing, candidate statements, and associated fees. Trustees discussed expanding the election from two to four seats, including two currently vacant positions. Trustees voted unanimously to approve an amended

resolution to fill four trustee seats.

**5.B RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY - S. LOUPE, PUBLIC WORKS
ADMINISTRATOR- Update regarding debris removal and levee repair
projects**

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer reported significant progress, with four of five debris piles removed, and the final pile scheduled for burning pending permit coordination. Levee repairs have FEMA's approval and are proceeding cautiously due to weather conditions. Additional work on Lovers Lane levee embankment repairs is also progressing, subject to weather.

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer provided an update, noting substantial advancement in FEMA reimbursement processes, with projects nearing final steps for funding authorization.

The Trustees discussed submitting letters of interest to the U.S. Army Corps for levee safety assessments and assistance with comprehensive floodplain management services, including flood mapping, technical support, and emergency response planning. Steve Loupe provided clarification on the different functions of the Army Corps groups involved, highlighting that one group specializes in levee inspections and maintenance assessments while another provides broader floodplain management support. Trustees agreed to submit the letters promptly to initiate these critical processes. Additionally, trustees emphasized the strategic importance of collaborating with agriculture businesses and county agricultural departments for potential funding opportunities to support levee maintenance and improvement projects.

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer reported that drone footage review indicated significant debris and vegetation that needs clearing, particularly west of Lovers Lane Bridge. Trustees deferred decision-making pending further evaluation.

He reaffirmed the commitment to actively seek state, federal, and private grant programs that could support levee improvements, flood mitigation efforts, and community resilience initiatives. Trustees agreed to remain vigilant and proactive in securing additional financial support to enhance district infrastructure and preparedness.

5.G RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AGENCY - S. LOUPE, PUBLIC WORKS ADMINISTRATOR- Update regarding the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) public webinars on the proposed CDBG-DR Action Plan, covering the 2023 and 2024 disasters.

Steve Loupe, Public Works Administrator, County Engineer provided a detailed overview of state-funded infrastructure and resilience grants, totaling \$11.5 million allocated specifically to San Benito County. This includes \$1.9 million designated explicitly for Lovers Lane infrastructure repairs, aimed at addressing critical flood damage and enhancing roadway safety. Additionally, \$9.5 million is potentially allocated for comprehensive flood management initiatives, including levee repairs, improvements, and preventive measures to bolster local infrastructure resilience. Trustees discussed strategies for leveraging these substantial funds to maximize community benefits, emphasizing the need to collaborate closely with local agencies, property owners, and stakeholders.

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

The Pacheco Storm Water District (PSWD) is actively working to increase community engagement and awareness about flood mitigation and levee repair efforts affecting residents along Lovers Lane. The second postcard creatively highlights the urgency of flood mitigation and safety, particularly for Lovers Lane, by incorporating direct and compelling wording alongside QR codes for accessible community interaction, encouraging immediate participation.

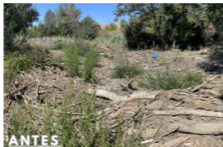
