Background

On June 8, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 958 calling and giving notice of the holding of the election on November 3, 2020. In addition, Resolution No. 958 authorized the City Clerk to coordinate with the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

Discussion

The County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk has certified the results of the City of Hidden Hills General Municipal Election held on November 3, 2020, and provided the official Certificate of Canvass of the Election Returns and the Final Official Statement of Votes Cast by Precinct for the City of Hidden Hills.

The results of the canvass of the votes cast for Member of the City Council has determined that Eniko Gold (656) and Steve Freedland (692) are the elected and qualified members of the City Council.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council approve Resolution No. 967 entitled: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020 DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

RESOLUTION NO. 967

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020 DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Hidden Hills, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Council's request and delegation of authority through Resolution No. 958 adopted on June 8, 2020, the County of Los Angeles Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk, Election Coordination Section, canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A".

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the precinct, including any provisional ballots and excluding vote-by-mail ballots, was 241.

That the whole number of vote-by-mail ballots cast in the City, including any provisional vote-by-mail ballots, was 997, for a grand total of 1238 ballots cast in the City of Hidden Hills.

SECTION 2. That the three (3) names of the persons (alpha order) voted for in the election for Member of the City Council were as follows:

Steve Freedland

Bret Katz

SECTION 3. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates was as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

SECTION 4. The City Council does declare and determine that and determine that: Eniko Gold (656) was elected as Member of the City Council for the term of 4 years and Steve Freedland (692) was elected as Member of the City Council for the term of 4 years;

SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person, and (5) The total number of votes given to each person.

SECTION 6. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver, to each of the persons so elected, a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

CITY COUNCIL COMMENTS

Council Member McCorkindale congratulated recent reelected Council Member Freedland and Council Member Elect Eniko Gold. She also reported that she and City Manager Kallman continue to work Southern California Edison and Charter/Spectrum with regards to providing internet for the residents who have generators during power outages. She also reported that she will be in attendance at a meeting with a small group who are considering putting forth a statewide initiative that's already been written that would limit all of this housing legislation.

STAFF COMMENTS

City Manager Kallman reported that for the last couple of months, staff has been recruiting for a new full-time position, Administrative Analyst. Recruitment started in August and closed on October 1. The City received 41 applications. Seven potential candidates were selected and an interview panel that included the City Managers of Bradbury and Rolling Hills, and the Deputy City Manager of

Westlake Village, was conducted, all via Zoom. Of the seven potential candidates, three of them were interviewed again but by City Manager Kallman this time. The candidate selected was Chantelle Limon.

Ms. Limon stated that she was honored to be here tonight. She graduated from UC Santa Barbara with a degree in political science in 2008 and in 2019 she earned her MPPA from Cal Lutheran University. She has interned with the City of Camarillo and worked for an elected official over the years. She's very excited for this opportunity and looks forward to serving the community of Hidden Hills.

PUBLIC HEARING

Minor Accommodation 5857 Fitzpatrick Road Remodel

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS SITTING AS THE PLANNING AGENCY, APPROVING A REQUEST FOR A MINOR ACCOMMODATION TO REMODEL AN EXISTING NONCONFORMING RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 5857 FITZPATRICK ROAD

At this time, Council Member Weber recused himself and left the meeting room, as he lives within 300' of the subject property.

City Engineer Lovett presented the following report:

a Minor Accommodation is being requested to remodel over 50% of the house; the existing single family residence is encroaching 27' into the required 50' front setback and 14' into the required 50' front setback (approximately 23' from the road right away to the south); the applicant is also proposing a one-story addition to approximately 491 square feet, which is all within the required setbacks; proposed improvements are all within the current footprint of the existing building and have been approved by the Hidden Hills Community Association; the project will require the undergrounding of utility lines; notices were sent to all property owners within a 500-foot radius of the subject property and posted at City Hall, with no public comments being received; the City Council may grant the Minor Accommodation if the Council finds that it will not have a material adverse impact on the public welfare or adjacent property; staff has determined the finding can be made because none of the proposed improvements would encroach any further into the required setback than the encroachments currently existing, and the

proposed improvements within the setback will not be out of character with other homes on Fitzpatrick Road.

At this point, Mayor Katz opened the public hearing. As there were no comments or objections, Mayor Katz then closed the hearing. Mayor Katz asked which Council Members had visited the site – Mayor Katz and Council Members Freedland and Weber reported they had been to the site, while Mayor Pro Tem Siegel and Council Member McCorkindale have not.

As there was no further discussion, upon MOTION of Council Member Freedland, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Siegel and carried on roll call vote, it was resolved to approve the minor accommodation and to adopt by title only Resolution No. 965 entitled: A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIDDEN HILLS SITTING AS THE PLANNING AGENCY, APPROVING A REQUEST FOR A MINOR ACCOMMODATION TO REMODEL AN EXISTING NONCONFORMING RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 5857 FITZPATRICK ROAD.

Upon MOTION of Council Member Freedland, seconded by Council Member Weber and unanimously carried on roll call vote, it was resolved to approve items A, B, C, D, E and F of the consent calendar as submitted.

OLD BUSINESS

A. Update on the City's Fiber to the Home Project

City Manager Kallman reported that this is a long-term goal of the City Council and that a consultant, Magellan Advisors, was hired to assist with this project. Earlier in the spring, an RFP was released to seek proposals to build a new fiber to the home network. The Ad hoc Committee, which consists

of Mayor Katz and Council Member Katz, has been working on this monthly with staff and the

consultant. Jory Wolf, our Consultant is here to update the Council on where we are, some of the

conclusions of the RFP process and some potential recommendations.

Jory Wolf, Magellan Advisors, provided a detailed Power Point presentation that looked at the goals

of the RFP, what Hidden Hills is looking for in terms of broadband services for its residents,

processes that Magellan has been engaged in with the Ad-hoc Committee and staff, work that has

been done with the finalists and their proposals (negotiating quite a bit about finding alternative and

creative ways to lower costs.

City Manager Kallman added that at the last City Council meeting, Magellan made a series of

recommended next steps for consideration by the City Council, which included performing a

subscriber commitment survey to formalize the networks revenue opportunities. At the conclusion

of that discussion, the City Council gave staff direction to bring back an extension to the City's

agreement with Magellan Advisors to design and perform a survey, and continue negotiations with

potential providers following the results of the survey. Magellan Advisors is also requesting

additional payment (Phase 1 extension) for hours that were exceeded under the previous agreement.

After a lengthy discussion by the City Council that included questions and/or comments, such as

confirming that construction of laterals to the house is part of the proposals, what the take rates will

be, maintenance of the system being included in proposals, and survey questions to include.

After review the attached proposal from Magellan Advisors by the City Council, they authorized the

City Manager to enter into the proposed agreement extension.

B. Consideration of Landscape Design Firm for the Round Meadow Road/Mureau Road

Project

City Engineer Lovett presented the following report:

at the June 22, 2020 City Council meeting, three (3) proposals for landscape renovations to

the Round Meadow/Mureau Road Intersection were considered; the City Council assigned a total budget of \$150,000 for this renovation project and directed staff to ask two (2) of the landscapers to revise and resubmit their proposals with this budget, for which the City has received; on August 10, 2020, the City Council further directed staff to request both landscapers for \$5,000 each, to provide detailed conceptual designs for which both L. Newman and Seed Landcare have provided.

At this time, Lynne Burns from Seed Landcare and Bob Bombardier from L. Newman Design Group shared their Power Point presentations, showing concepts including types of plants, plans for the refurbishment of the existing gazebo or ideas for a replacement gazebo, lighting, drip replacement, furniture, etc.

Council Member Freedland stated that he thought both companies are very competent and while both their concepts were good, he felt that he would like to award L. Newman Design Group this project due to the fact that they have done other projects in the past and it would keep a cohesiveness to the City landscaping at the front gate and he would also like to see the gazebo refurbished instead of replaced, which is included in L. Newman's design.

Council Member McCorkindale also thought both companies did a very good job on their concepts. She has felt that Seed Landcare's concept would fit more with most of the landscaping inside the City, which is the company that the Hidden Hills Community Association uses. She believes that Seed Landcare is extraordinary, feels they have incredible integrity.

Mayor Katz stated that he like both designs but that he feels that the existing gazebo is a fixture and would like to keep it and refurbish it. Council Member Weber agreed with Mayor Katz and would like to see the gazebo stay and refurbished.

Mayor Pro Tem Siegel agreed with Council Member Freedland's comments and thought that both concepts were good. He would like to keep the gazebo and feels that as L. Newman is designing the front gate project, he would like to see continuity in the projects, and would select L. Newman for the project.

Upon MOTION by Council Member Freedland, and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Siegel resolved to select L. Newman Design Group as the landscape design consultant for the Round Meadow/Mureau Road intersection landscape renovation project, and to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with L. Newman Design Group. The motion carried 3-2 by the following voice vote:

AYES: Mayor Katz, Mayor Pro Tem Siegel, and Council Member Freedland

NOES: Council Member McCorkindale and Council Member Weber

C. Update and Discussion on City Council Goals

City Manager Kallman presented the following report:

in June, the Council met and approved a list of goals; staff presents a semi quarterly report that updates the goals; following is the status of those goals:

1. Consider various funding mechanisms for undergrounding of power poles throughout the City. In addition, consider a large scale "Undergrounding" project for Fiscal Year 2018/19

The Long Valley undergrounding project is underway. The project is on time and on task and moving along. Staff and the Ad hoc Committee had a meeting and discussed another area on Jed Smith from Hoback Glen to Dixon Trail.

Mr. Kallman asked the legislative committee, Mayor Pro Tem Siegel and Council Member McCorkindale about funding opportunities to assist cities with undergrounding projects.

Council Member McCorkindale stated that Hidden Hills may be interested in joining with a couple of other cities who are already in the process of considering writing legislation that would help fund communities and cities that want to underground. At a recent Montecito Association meeting, they were in the process of finding other cities to join with to create some legislation that would require Edison and or the local electric company and or the state to very significantly pay for the underground. We have been in some discussions with the other city about bringing in the third city that's a little bit more diverse into this possible They had their Board of Supervisors representative, their Assembly Member representative and their State Senate representative and they said they are going to find a way to help us and others in higher zones get this done.

2. 2020 goal - Reinitiate the 2017 Goal to improve cell coverage in the City by actively engaging both cell providers and potential consultants to assist the City.

Staff held an initial call with a Verizon representative about potential cell coverage improvements. At that time, there was no immediate plans for Verizon improvements in the City. Council Member McCorkindale asked if Magellan have a person that specializes in getting some of these carriers into cities or do they not offer that. She asked that between now and the next goal update, could we talk with to Magellan about what services they offer. City Manager Kallman thought that was a good idea and will work on a potential proposal and also explore other groups that might have some ideas on how to help.

3. Continue the internal and external upgrade of City Hall. Areas of focus may include City Council Chambers, upstairs conference room, and Building and Safety. External upgrades to consider include new roof and solar project.

At the March 2020 City Council Goals session, the Ad-Hoc Committee of Council Member's Weber and McCorkindale and staff presented three concepts for renovation of City Hall: (1) partial remodel with an approximate cost of \$450,000; (2) full remodel with an approximate cost of \$750,000 - \$2 million; or (3) a total rebuild with an approximate cost of \$4 million. Based on the number of desired and necessary upgrades and large maintenance needs, the Ad-hoc Committee recommended consideration of the total rebuild. As the Goals session was held on March 9 as the concerns of the Covid-19 pandemic, further discussion was tabled.

Council Member McCorkindale explained that she and Council Member Weber volunteered for this Ad hoc Committee. A concept that was beautiful, safe and environmentally responsible was created. After going through the process for over a year, the Ad hoc Committee felt that it would be more fiscally responsible to rebuild the building. The concept was brought before the Council in that goal session and the response was a bit challenging and we all agreed, even into April, that there was just no resonance in the air to focus on it at that time. With COVID-19, most City employees worked remotely from home for months. As the pandemic has continued, City Hall has remained closed to the public and as such, all City meetings are being done via ZOOM and will most likely to continue into the distant future. If the City Council wants to do a rebuild or remodel of City Hall, this would be the time to do it as it's been predicted cities may stay on ZOOM for another 12 months and there's some ease with working at home for staff. The Ad hoc Committee would like direction at this time from the rest of the Council as to whether or not they would like to continue with the project.

Mayor Pro Tem Siegel is concerned with spending the money for the fact that there are still critical issues to be resolved in the City, like cell service/fiber and utility undergrounding.

City Manager Kallman suggested that the Council give staff an opportunity to regroup and put together a presentation for the Council that will include items that have already been completed and what are the deferred maintenance items that add timelines, potential costs, and options.

Council Member Freedland stated that he cannot consider spending \$4 million to rebuild City Hall. He feels that it does not serve the residents of Hidden Hills and if the City is going to spend that kind of money, that it was spent on improving cell service for everybody, or subsidize more of the fiber to the home. Mr. Freedland does recognize that there's deferred maintenance that needs to be done and that having a contractor evaluate City Hall and give staff an estimate to cure those deficiencies and other necessary upgrades.

Mayor Katz agrees with Mr. Kallman's suggestion to regroup and put together a presentation for a future Council meeting.

City Manager Kallman stated that in terms of the budget, there's \$200,000 set aside as a placeholder for potential improvements that have been used on design and that could be used for emergency repairs to City Hall, and also improvement purchases like the office furniture that was bought for \$3,000 to create workstations for staff. That's what this \$200,000 is for. The City has \$500,000 in reserves set aside for building maintenance as well.

Council Member McCorkindale inquired from the Council, that if the Ad hoc Committee was able to secure a portion or half of the expense of rebuilding City Hall in grants, would the Council feel differently about rebuilding the City Hall?

Council Member Freedland agreed that if a significant amount of grants were obtained, it would make the rebuild a viable project and the Council may be more inclined to approve.

Mayor Pro Tem Siegel stated that if the use of general funds can be significantly reduced, and we can justify to the community and explain we're not doing this alone but with grants, then yes it's a viable project.

Mayor Katz also agreed that it is a viable project if grant funds can be obtained and less general funds are spent. However, the main concern is the deferred maintenance right now and needs to be addressed immediately.

City Manager Kallman stated that staff has enough direction and will bring this item back as soon as possible.

Mayor Pro Tem Siegel stated that the only significant item discussed was the South Bay Cities COG broadband project, for which Supervisor Kuehl opposed the use of Measure M funds to pay for as it was not related to transit or highways.

Due to the late hour, it was decided that a Closed Session was not necessary at this time.

MONTHLY DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Los Angeles County Fire Department Reports—September and October Assistant Fire Chief Drew Smith and Community Services Liaison Megan Currier

Assistant Fire Chief Drew Smith presented the following report:

the month of September had 7 medical responses, 5 service calls, 4 good intent calls, and 1 fire call for a downed power line for a total of 17 responses. For the month of October there was 6 medical responses, 1 service call, 1 hazardous condition (downed power line), and 2 good intent calls.

Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Reports – September and October Captain Sal Becerra, Lt. Joseph Fender and Deputy Rich Baldi

Captain Becerra presented the following report:

during the month of September there was one Part I crime: A theft occurred in the 24800 block of Jim Bridger Road. A package was stolen from the location. A Thousand Oaks resident was arrested for a warrant in the area of Long Valley Road. A resident of Reseda was arrested for public intoxication in the 6100 block of Spring Valley Road. There were six calls for trespassing. During the month of October there were no Part 1 crimes. There were five calls for trespassing.

Captain Becerra also stated that it appears that "Chilean type" burglaries may have occurred in neighboring jurisdictions. Residents should take necessary steps to protect their houses. He also added that residents can call the station and ask for the Watch Commander when seeking information.

City Engineer Report

City Engineer Lovett presented the following report:

1) Long Valley Entrance Improvement Project – the HHCA submitted gate plans to the City this month but is still working on the specs. 2) Overhead Power Lines Undergrounding - unmarked and unclaimed utility lines were encountered, that were in conflict with the proposed undergrounding, causing roughly a 3-week delay. These conflicts have been resolved and work is scheduled to be complete by December 23. Some of the vaults have been installed, with one remaining vault and the trenching to commence

next week. SCE will hopefully commence the removal of the poles in January/February. 3) LVMWD Jim Bridger and Long Valley Roads Repairs - water main repairs on Long Valley Road (between Hilltop Road and Lasher Road) and Jim Bridger (south of Ashley Ridge Road). The work on Long Valley Road is being coordinated with the City's utility undergrounding project. Construction on Jim Bridger Road is substantially complete. Construction on Long Valley Road will continue through the end of this month. The District will commence transitioning residents to the new water main the week of November 30th, 2020 and will provide door tags to affected residents to provide ample notice to residents. All clean up is scheduled to be complete by the end of this month or the first week in December. 4) Mureau Road Landscaping - Council at its November 9, 2020 meeting. The City Council selected L. Newman Design Group to do this design. Staff is preparing an agreement. 5) High Pressure Gas line at 5949 and 6006 Spring Valley Road - City staff attended a meeting at the construction site with the builder, the Gas Company and PUC on 11/12/20. The Gas Company approved all equipment and construction at the site to date. The PUC representative indicated that he saw no violations but wanted to further review the property survey to verify that the structure was not built within the gas line easement. No plans have been submitted to the City for 5949 Spring Valley Road.

PRESENTATION

Financial Audit for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Brett Van Lant, CPA, Partner, VLF, LLP

City Treasurer Mike Blazenski introduced the Mr. Van Lant from VLF, LLP, whose company performed the City of Hidden Hills' 2019-2020 Financial Audit. Mr. Van Lant explained that the audit is a two part process which includes internal control and compliance over financial reporting. After evaluating and verifying balances and observation of different processes, VLF, LLP has no issues to bring to the City Council's attention.

Mr. Van Lant thanked City Treasurer Blazenski and Accounting Specialist Theresa Folk for all their assistance in ensuring that the audit process went smoothly.

The City Council thanked staff and Mr. Van Lant for a very complete and thorough report.

NEW BUSINESS

Consideration of a Change in Deployment with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and Purchase of a Patrol Vehicle

City Manager Kallman presented the following report:

in 2018, the City made a change to its deployment level with the Sheriff's Department, with the addition of eight hours per week of Deputy Sheriff time; those hours were added to the twenty hours per week of motorcycle Deputy time in the City, to work with residents, city staff and security on any issues, including assistance on investigations, patrols of the trails, and follow up on any outstanding issues; Deputy Mike Ranes was the assigned Deputy to this position, and after doing an excellent job in piloting this new deployment strategy, Deputy Ranes announced he will be retiring after 27 years in early 2021; the new Deputy Sheriff that will fill this position has to have the right temperament to continue work with the residents, staff and security company, along with a flexible schedule; staff and the Sheriff's Department to ensure placement of the best qualified Deputy was to create the "Growth Deputy Generalist"; staff presented the concept to the City Council and included these costs in the FY 2020/21 City budget, with staff anticipating those costs would be effective January 1, 2021; several potential candidates were discussed and it was recommended that Deputy Rick Baldi, a 14-year veteran of the Department who was previously assigned to a similar role in the City of Agoura Hills and served as Deputy Ranes back-up in Hidden Hills when Deputy Ranes was on vacation or needed assistance, would be the right fit; staff is recommending the City officially change its deployment schedule with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department to provide for a full-time primary Deputy to serve the residents of Hidden Hills effective on January 1, 2021; this new Growth Deputy position requires that any City contracting this position provide a dedicated patrol car for the Deputy for a one time cost of approximately \$75,000; there is also a net change in costs for the new position for approximately \$10,000 for FY 2020/21, which both of these costs were anticipated in the FY 2020/21 City budget.

The City Council authorized change in Sheriff's Department deployment discussed above, and authorized staff to purchase a new patrol vehicle for the exclusive use of the primary Hidden Hills Deputy.

Consideration of a Proposed Agreement Extension with Magellan Advisors to Perform a Community Broadband Survey and Continue Negotiations with Potential Providers

City Manager Kallman presented the following report:

the City Council approved an agreement with Magellan Advisors in 2019 to provide consulting services to the City's Fiber to the Home project; in 2020, the City issued a request for proposal seeking construction and operation of a new fiber network by a private telecommunications firm, two selected for further discussion and negotiation, and those discussions have been occurring regularly since April 2020; Magellan Advisors provided a detailed update on the project to the City Council on November 9, 2020, for which the City Council gave staff direction to bring back an extension to the City's agreement with Magellan to perform a community broadband survey and continue negotiations; Magellan Advisors is also requesting additional payment for hours that were exceeded under the previous agreement.

Upon MOTION of Council Member Weber, seconded by Council Member McCorkindale and unanimously carried on roll call vote, it was resolved to approve the Magellan Agreement Extension for the amount of \$12,600 and approve the amount of \$7,350 in overages from Phase 1 for a total amount of \$19,950.

Report from 11/17/20 Hidden Hills Community Association Board of Directors Meeting

HHCA Board Member John McGinnis presented the following report:

the Board received a presentation by the LVMWD regarding the new generator that is to be installed behind the little red bus stop on the corner of Round Meadow and Jed Smith Road, and what the LVMWD has proposed is not aesthetically pleasing, nor does it represent Hidden Hills, as it is very industrial looking; the Board is asking for assistance from the City to negotiate something that fits in more with Hidden Hills, as the LVMWD will need a lot line adjustment and this item will come to the City Council for approval; the Board recognized outgoing Board Members Alex Werner Resnick and David Zebrack; tabled an anti-harassment policy; approved a

revision to the filming requirements, there was no motion on the drone policy so it died; and the Board approved new horse jumps and poles for the Spring Valley arena.

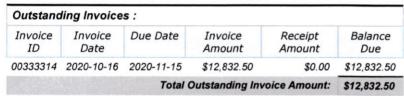

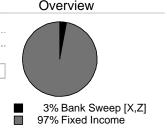
