In addition, this request seeks approval for the expansion of the West Tower pneumatic tube system, the DTC pneumatic zones, and the conversion of the pneumatic lab to an Xpress Station. Finally, the Facilities Design and Construction Department is seeking approval for additional pneumatic tube stations for the Emergency Department (ED) Expansion Project (ongoing services).

Background

Swisslog is the original pneumatic tube vendor for the Trust, providing equipment and services for over twenty years. As the current vendor under contract with the Trust, Swisslog has deep knowledge of the system configuration and hardware structure. In 2022, Swisslog was awarded \$510,190 approved under Resolution No. PHT 12/2022-059. These dollars included \$389,180 for an overhaul of the existing pneumatic tube system at Jackson Memorial Medical Center Campus. In addition, \$121,010 of that amount included a five (5)-year Maintenance Agreement for the TransLogic Pneumatic Tube System (PTS) at Jackson West Medical Center. Prior to the award for overhaul at Jackson Main Campus, Swisslog had been providing pneumatic system maintenance service under a one (1) year agreement, which will expire in September 2023. Ideally, the pneumatic tube system connects JHS' wards, surgical rooms and departments with the hospitals' central pharmacy and laboratories, allowing the hospitals to exchange information at rapid speeds and eliminates the time-consuming process of human transport of information/specimens.

In providing a statement on the benefit, to the Trust, of engaging the Swisslog, the Facilities Design and Construction and Engineering Departments have offered that the TransLogic PTS is custom designed to meet the unique transport needs of every JHS facility. Delivering efficiencies through automated material transport, the TransLogic PTS allows the hospitals to reduce operational costs and improve quality of care by redeploying personnel to patient-facing activities.

As a result of the successful maintenance agreement initiated at Jackson West and the current one (1) year agreement at Jackson Main Campus, Engineering Services requests approval to procure an additional four (4) years of maintenance service for Main Campus. The additional four (4) years of maintenance will cover quarterly preventive maintenance site visits, software updates, emergency response, and system spare parts. A fully operational pneumatic tube system, providing a quicker turnaround time of transporting lab specimens, reduces the patient's length of stay. The expedited delivery time, utilizing the pneumatic tube system, also reduces the wait time for test results, thus improving efficiencies. This results in medical staff being more available to attend to patients' needs. Also, a functional system reduces the need for extra staff to handle manual transport and delivery of specimens and medications. Jackson Health System has over 70 stations, 12 blowers, and 63 transfer units installed by Swisslog. Therefore, it is advantageous to engage Swisslog, the original manufacturer of the equipment, to provide proper and timely maintenance.

Swisslog's preventive maintenance price increases have been historically at an average of 5% annually. However, in continuing to provide service to Jackson Memorial, the vendor has committed to extending to the Trust its 2022 pricing for Year 2 fees. The fees for years 3 – 5 will be increased by an average of 2.4% rather than the average 5% annual increase. This represents total savings to the Trust of \$30,690.85 for the additional four years. In addition, spare parts are discounted at 20% based on a five (5) year Agreement.

As a result of numerous simulations performed on the campus-wide system, Engineering Services has concluded that the current tube system can no longer support the additional traffic being generated by the new Rehabilitation Hospital Tower and DTC Vertical Expansion. To resolve the aforementioned, Swisslog proposes the East and West Tower interchanges be upgraded to Xpress Zones. In addition, the Diagnostic Treatment Center (DTC) would benefit from its own dedicated zone. This dedicated zone would allow specimen tube traffic within DTC to flow without the delay of waiting for tube carriers to travel to the new DTC zone. Currently, the Pneumatic Laboratory is the primary station for sending and receiving system-wide tube carriers (the capsules that travel through the tubes). Engineering Services desires to upgrade the laboratory to an Xpress Zone station. The upgrade allows tube carriers to be sent and received separately and simultaneously. This conversion would result in the sending and receiving of these carriers every ten seconds.

Facilities Design and Construction is managing the Emergency Department (ED) Expansion Project, which includes installation of new TransLogic pneumatic tube stations in nurse areas. The connection of the new pneumatic tube routing to the main system along with transfer stations, and the addition of blowers to support the pneumatic extension, will facilitate the connection of the ED expansion to the lab and pharmacy pneumatic systems in the main hospital. These upgrades will result in an expedited pneumatic transport system hospital-wide, which will result in a faster turnaround time for lab results as well as quicker medication delivery to patients.

In its analysis, ECRI stated that, due to the lack of a directly comparable record, the company is unable to provide a pricing recommendation. In addition, labor rates are often difficult to compare as they vary regionally and in union and non-union environments. Therefore, ECRI is unable to compare the cost provided to the Trust with those of similar configurations. A search within the ECRI Alerts database has found no recent hazards, recalls, or issues with the system.

Recommendation

The Engineering Services Department at Main Campus has determined that it is in the best interest of the Trust to maintain the JHS standard and maintenance services of pneumatic tube systems, including future procurement of equipment, installation, repairs, and maintenance services for a period of up to five (5) years with Swisslog. In addition, the Engineering Services Department recommends the award of a standardization bid waiver contract to Swisslog for the East and West Tower interchanges to be converted to Xpress Zones, the Diagnostic Treatment Center (DTC) to have its own dedicated zone, and the Pneumatic Laboratory to be upgraded to an Xpress Zone station.

Facilities Design and Construction Department has also determined that it is in the best interest of the Trust to award a standardization bid waiver contract to Swisslog for inclusion of additional tube systems and the connection of the lab and pharmacy systems to the main system as part of the new ED Expansion Project scope.

In addressing environmental sustainability in line with the Trust's environmentally sustainable initiatives, Swisslog has offered the following: "Sustainability in our supply chain means we ensure the materials, goods, utilities, and services that we need are always sourced in an environmentally friendly, responsible and ethical way. We evaluate and continually monitor suppliers based on key sustainability parameters. Our approach is to check all the important and necessary aspects of sustainability. We work with our suppliers to conduct business in line with sustainable procurement principles and to continuously improve processes."

This procurement has been reviewed for SBE participation. This engagement is for maintenance, parts, and software services to support the Translogic pneumatic tube system. Services will be performed by Swisslog Healthcare employees. Swisslog Healthcare is aware of Jackson's SBE program and the expectation of vendor partners to advance that commitment.

The vendor took no exception to the Trust's standard terms and conditions, which have been approved by Risk Management as to Insurance and Liability and by the County Attorney's Office for legal sufficiency.

The Contract may be terminated by the Trust for convenience (without cause) upon thirty (30) calendar days prior written notice of termination and includes the UAP and OIG fees. These fees are provided as deductions on the invoices.

In accordance with the Contractor Due Diligence review, Swisslog has provided a Sworn/Notarized Statement to the Trust's Procurement Management Department that: (1) no Lawsuits have been filed against the Company within the five (5) years prior to submittal of a bid or proposal to the Trust; (2) the Company has not defaulted in the five (5) years prior to bid or proposal submittal to the Trust; and. (3) the Company has not been debarred nor has the Firm received a formal notice of non-compliance or non-performance in the five (5) years prior to proposal submittal to the Trust.

In providing an evaluation of the vendor's performance during the current contract year, Engineering Services has reported the following:

- Vendor meets the standard for deliverables in accordance with contract requirements
- Vendor meets standards for average turnaround time of goods/services/delivery
- Vendor meets the standard in response to emergency situations
- Vendor meets required standard in responsiveness to safety issues and safety standards
- Vendor meets standard relative to competencies of contracted staff.

A Bid Waiver Justification has been provided and Conflict of Interest declarations signed by Loyman Marin, Vice President, Engineering Services, JHS Main Campus; Jorge Garciga, Director, Facilities Design and Construction, JHS; and Jennie McQuade, Secretary, Translogic d/b/a Swisslog Healthcare Solutions, with no reported disclosures (**L. Marin, B. Seed**).

(“KSM”) to exercise the first option to renew and to secure KSM’s assistance with the implementation of a Federally Qualified Health Center – Look Alike (“FQHC-LA”) (ongoing purchase).

Background

On October 26, 2022, the Trust and KSM entered into the Professional Services Agreement (“Agreement”) for a period of one year, with one option to renew (OTR), via which KSM has assessed the feasibility, and identified the financial implications, of the Trust securing an FQHC-LA designation. Given KSM's expertise and familiarity with the Trust's structure and operations, the Trust would like to continue to utilize KSM for this second phase, which involves implementing the FQHC-LA designation, developing the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) application and preparing for the HRSA site visit. As such, the JHS Executive Office is requesting approval to modify the Agreement with KSM to add services related to the FQHC-LA implementation and HRSA application and to exercise the option to renew for one year, which will extend the contract through October 25, 2024.

KSM will provide the following services during the renewal period:

1. Establishment of a road map to guide the Trust through the process of planning and implementing an FQHC-LA. In doing so, KSM will involve appropriate legal counsel for certain aspects of the project such as the review and development of legal documents.
2. Pre-planning discussion and agreement with a project steering committee
3. Assistance to the Trust in developing and implementing the FQHC-LA legal structure, subject to the approval by Miami-Dade Board of County Commission. This activity will involve multiple activities related to formation of the legal entity, formation and education of the governing board, and readiness assessment to ensure that the existing primary care practices comply with FQHC-LA requirements. The activities will include the following:
 - a. Provision of oversight and guidance in the development of legal documents to establish the Health Center, in partnership with Taft Law and the Miami-Dade County Attorney’s Office.
 - b. Provision of oversight and guidance in the development of legal documents that clarify the relationship between the Trust and the FQHC-LA, in partnership with Taft Law and the Miami-Dade County Attorney’s Office.
 - c. KSM will provide advisory services related to formation and operation of the FQHC-LA governing board.
 - d. KSM will conduct readiness assessment to ensure that existing practices comply with FQHC-LA guidelines.
 - e. Development of an action plan to address issues identified during the readiness assessment.
 - f. Preparation for HRSA site visit.

KSM’s fees are based on the number of hours spent, the complexity of the services, and the experience of the individuals assigned to the engagement. The Trust will also be billed for any travel and other out-of-pocket costs, pursuant to the limits dictated under Florida Statutes, Section 112.061. KSM’s total fee for the renewal term will not exceed \$295,000. Fees are inclusive of legal fees and dependent on timely receipt of data and adherence to a regular meeting cadence.

Recommendation

The Executive Office has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Trust to utilize KSM's services to assist in the implementation of an FQHC-LA. Securing an FQHC-LA designation will allow the Trust to improve the health status of the uninsured and Medicaid population, reduce unnecessary emergency room utilization, and optimize Medicaid reimbursement. The financial lift associated with securing an FQHC-LA will support the Trust's long-term financial plan. KSM will also assist the Trust with the Health Resources and Services Administration (“HRSA”) application and to prepare for the HRSA site visit.

This procurement has been thoroughly reviewed for potential SBE participation. The services provided under this consulting agreement will be performed by KSM Business Services and may include services from subcontractors specialized in the scope of work. The opportunity to include an SBE partner is not available for this purchase at this time. KSM Business Services is aware of Jackson’s SBE program and the expectation of vendor partners to advance that commitment.

The underlying Agreement can be terminated by either party for convenience upon thirty (30) calendar days' notice and includes the OIG and UAP fees. The OIG and UAP fees are provided as deductions on the invoices.

A Bid Waiver Justification has been provided and Conflict of Interest Declarations have been signed by Mark Knight, Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, Jackson Health System; Kevin Newingham, Director, KSM; and, Steve Warner, Vice President, KSM, with no reported disclosures **(M. Knight)**.

WHEREAS, this Board is proud to provide the Hyperbaric Chamber to a worthy cause,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH TRUST OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board hereby:

Section 1. Adopts the foregoing recitals.

Section 2.
