RE: Stop Sign, Gage Street at Farrelly

Dear President Shaut:

In reviewing the site and city code, I found that there is no stop sign legislated or installed on Gage Street at Farrelly. Traffic engineering considerations require that a stop sign be added on Gage at this location. Currently stop signs are legislated and installed on Farrelly Street. I suggest that those signs remain due to sight distance limitations for the driveway located at the intersection, and since the stop signs on Farrelly seem well-accepted. "All-Way" plaques should be added to all 3 stop signs when the change is made.

Esteemed Aldermen and Alderwomen:

Below please see my recommendations relative to the items on this agenda:

2.a Handicap Parking, 103 Hone Street. Engineering does not object to the request. On-street parking is permitted at this location. Engineering does not take a position on whether handicap parking should be issued at any given location.

2.b Hunter and Abeel Street Intersection (add STOP sign on Abeel): I am not ready to make a recommendation on this item yet. I did visit the site and observe traffic flow. I have also requested the crash reports for this location, but I do not yet have the response. I anticipate being able to respond to this request in 1-2 weeks with my recommendation, following further review. I suggest tabling this item at your meeting.

2.c Handicap Parking Sign Michele Hirsch (duplicate request for 2.a)

2.d No Parking, No Standing 106 & 94 Merilina Avenue. This location is near Edson Elementary School. Parking is already prohibited from 7:30 am – 4 pm, M-F, at this location by City Code, 390-99, Schedule XVI. Signage should be installed in field to agree with the city code.

2.e Removal of Traffic Signals – I plan to address the committee with an update on the status and preliminary findings of the study. Representatives of Ulster County will also attend.

2.f Line Striping, 146 Delaware (signalized intersection of North Street and Delaware Ave) I concur with the recommendation to install painted white stop bars at the signal. It appears there were stop bars painted here, they may have simply faded away.

*3.a Stop Signs, Lincoln and Grant- I previously responded to this, about 1-month ago.

3.b 25 MPH speed limit – I do not have any comments at this time

3.c No Parking, Joys Lane near funeral home. This appears to be an enforcement issue. I do not recommend adding additional signage to prevent an issue that is already covered by state and local laws, namely that parking cannot block a driveway.

I plan to attend the meeting on 10/23 and will be available to answer any questions you may have.
