At the request of Alderman Davis, I evaluated this location for adding a STOP sign for westbound West Pierpont Street at McEntee Street.

My recommendation is to revise the Code Chapter 390 Vehicles and Traffic as follows:

Add to 390-92 Schedule IX: Stop intersections:

- West Pierpont Street westbound at McEntee Street
- West Pierpont Street eastbound at Ravine Street

In addition, MUTCD R1-3P "All Way" plaques should be installed at all 4 legs of the intersection.
