Summary of Proposal ProHealth has submitted a sign permit for two ground signs. Pertinent regulations are found in s. 64-23(g) of the sign code

Sign #3 is located along Maple Avenue near the north lot line. It will be located in the same location as the previous sign. The sign as proposed does not comply with the maximum height of 14 feet (16 feet is proposed) and the sign area of 100 square feet (128 square feet is proposed). In addition, there must be a masonry base – none is indicated.

Sign #4 is located along the north access road at near the parking lot entrance and complies. The sign as proposed complies with the area and height requirements, but does not have a masonry base.

Review procedure The Plan Commission is advisory to the Village Board, which makes the final decision.


Even though the signs do not comply as proposed, the modifications are deemed comparatively minor and can be verified by the Zoning Administrator before issuance of the building permit.





RESOLUTION APPROVING SIGNAGE FOR APPLICANT PRAIRIE SIGN AND LIGHTING LLC; PROHEALTH CARE, OWNER 240 MAPLE AVE; PARCEL MUKV 2016-993-002

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 64-32, an application for signage is required to be accepted by the Zoning Administrator to review the applications for zoning compliance, which said application was filed in the office of the Village Clerk, Village of Mukwonago, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the application was submitted by Prairie Sign and Lighting LLC, 240 Maple Ave, and

WHEREAS, Section 64-32, subsection (b), requires Plan Commission review and recommendation of all signage for single tenant properties 3.01 acres or greater in size, and

WHEREAS, the proposed monument sign presented as meeting the requirements of Section 64-23(b) has been reviewed and recommended by the Village Plan Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Board of the Village of Mukwonago, Wisconsin hereby approves the proposed monument sign for ProHealth Care at 240 Maple Ave and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this wall sign approval shall be subject to the plans submitted by Pointe Apartments, as recommended by the Plan Commission on November 10, 2020, and on file in the office of the Zoning Administrator, with the following conditions:

- 1. Sign #3 must be revised to comply with the sign area and height standards set forth in s. s. 64-23(g) of the sign code.
- 2. Sign #3 and #4 must be revised to include a masonry base as set forth in s. s. 64-23(g) of the sign code.
- 3. Both of signs must be set back at least 10 feet from the front property line and other property lines.
- 4. Both of the signs must be located outside of the 15-foot vision triangle of an intersecting street with a private driveway.
- 5. Prior to issuance of a building permit, the Zoning Administrator must verify compliance with paragraphs 1-4 above.
- 6. The property owner must obtain a building permit for the approved work within 6 months of this date and begin construction and work in good faith to completion.
- 7. The property owner must pay any outstanding application fees and other charges that may apply.
