Village Board,

This memo serves as a brief introduction to a grant opportunity for the Downtown area of Mukwonago.

#### Opportunity to Apply for CDI Grant and assist Downtown Development

#### **Project Status:**

Currently, we have one "Shovel ready project" regarding new constitution within the downtown area (301 Main). The CDI grant allows for applications by municipalities each year and is limited to one project. This project has received CDBG funding for brownfield clean up, received their entitlements approvals such as site plan and conditional use. They have received a portion of their state approved plans at this time and a few other approvals such as suppression is pending.

Due to the current market conditions of building materials and market supply of materials the development team has recalculated the cost of the project and the project cost has increased around \$250,000 or more. Staff began to look at other options to allow this project to go forward beyond the traditional bank loan and private equity. Staff has directed the development team to the Waukesha County Center for Growth to work on determining if programs such as the Grow Fund might assist the projects. In addition, staff has identified the Community Development Investment Grant (CDI) program as a possible financial opportunity.

The approval process for the grant is:

- 1. A pre-approval application which is currently being prepared by staff and the development
- 2. Review of the preapproval application by the state.
- 3. If the state grants preapproval, then the next step is to bring a resolution to the board for consideration directing staff to move forward with the grant application.
- 4. Submit Application

- 5. Review of Application by State
- 6. Issuance of grant by state / denial of grant by state.

#### **Community Development Investment Grant – Information about Grant**

#### Program Goal:

The goal of the Community Development Investment (CDI) Grant Program is to incent primarily downtown community development in the state of Wisconsin.

#### **Program Description:**

The program will support urban, small city and rural community redevelopment efforts by providing financial incentives for catalytic, shovel-ready projects with emphasis on, but not limited to, downtown community-driven efforts. Funded activities should lead to measurable benefits in job opportunities, property values and/or leveraged investment by local and private partners.

#### About:

The livelihood of our communities is directly linked to quality services and infrastructure that support economic competitiveness. Wisconsin communities that mobilize people and resources inspire positive and substantive local development. The Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation's (WEDC's) Community Development Investment (CDI) Grant Program helps transform communities by supporting local development that is as unique as the communities in Wisconsin.

#### How it works:

The CDI Grant Program will support urban, small city and rural community re/development efforts by providing financial incentives for shovel-ready projects with emphasis on, but not limited to, downtown community-driven efforts

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

Grant recipients must demonstrate significant, measurable benefits in job opportunities, property values and/or leveraged investment by local and private partners.

Eligible partners include designated rural counties, Opportunity Zone, and municipalities, tribal entities and government authorities designated by a municipality to apply.

#### General Conditions include:

- Grant recipients must provide a minimum 1:1 matching investment in project costs. For U.S.
   Economic Development Administration (EDA) CARES Act funded projects, the WEDC
   investment shall not exceed 20percent of the project budget.
- No more than 30% of the match investment may consist of other state and/or federal grant sources, unless the purpose of the funding is to provide match to an EDA CARES Act funded project.
- Applicants must provide a signed resolution by the governing elected body authorizing the submittal of an application to the CDI Grant Program
- Generally, applicants may only receive one CDI grant per fiscal year; applicants within
  Designated Rural Counties or Opportunity Zones may receive more than one grant per year,
  based on available funding.

- An applicant that was impacted by an event that has resulted in a State or Federal Disaster
  Declaration within the 24 months prior to submitting an application may receive funds for
  mitigation or preparedness planning and will receive additional considerations including the
  following:
  - WEDC may reduce or waive the match requirements
  - Applicants must demonstrate that other funding mechanisms (CDBG, WI Disaster Fund, FEMA, etc.) have been evaluated and fully utilized before applying for WEDC CDI Grant funding

- Infrastructure investment

- Rehabilitation and reuse of underutilized or landmark buildings

- Historic preservation
- Infrastructure efforts, including disaster prevention measures, providing substantial benefits to downtown residents or property owners
- Mixed-use development (not exclusively residential)

#### Incentives and Available Funding (FY21): \$8,000,000

- Funding will be limited to 50% of eligible project costs, with a maximum grant amount of up to \$250,000.
- At least 50% of the funds will be awarded to communities within Designated Rural Counties.

#### **Action Items:**

At this time there are no immediate actions for the board to take, however we do anticipate the possibility of having the pre-approval received from the state by the October 20<sup>th</sup> Board meeting, at which time we would seek action by the board on a resolution. A draft resolution is attached to this memo.

Village Board,

This memo serves as a brief introduction to a number inquires which staff has had regarding this parcel.

#### **Background:**

- Village Staff has been approached by two brokers regarding brokering and marketing this parcel. In addition, one of the brokers has proposed to purchase the parcel.
- At this time staff has not been focused on marketing or selling this parcel as other project have taken priority.
- Communication Staff has communicated to both individuals that to move forward staff would need to discuss this parcel with the Village Board, as well as, have a discussion on possible options about how the Village Board would like to proceed. Please see summary of options below.

#### **Options:**

Staff has evaluated a number of options which are summarized below:

#### Option A:

The Village could market the property by themselves via placing a sign on the property, listing the property on sites with minimal cost and using our legal services for any transactions.

#### Option B:

The Village could seek a broker to market the property. Staff would suggest that we send out a RFQ to local and regional brokers and then bring the RFQ to the Board for review and consideration so the

process is equitable for the brokerage professionals and the Board has competitive proposals to evaluate.

#### Option C:

The board might consider entering into an agreement for purchase similar to what the Village entered into in December of 2020 for the Hill Court Property.

#### Option D:

The board might consider retaining this parcel until development occurs on the Sommers parcel as a coordinated development east of HWY 83 might provide for better long-term planning and development patterns.

#### Option E:

As indicated the one development group has informally indicated they would like to purchase the property the Board could indicate that they would be willing to review an offer.

Note: The development team has indicated to staff that they would like staff to provide a cost per acreage, what incentives may or may not be available, and provide clarity as how much assistance the village will provide for utilities, road extension, stormwater pond creation, grading, and other items related to development. If the board decides to go in this direction staff will request clarity and boundaries with regard to the items noted above. In addition, staff believes that placing this property on the market or at least soliciting multiple purchase proposals may be in the best interest of the village rather than working with just one proposal.

#### Option F:

The Board might consider an option to maintain the status quo and any interested in the property can be brought to the board for consideration one at a time.

#### **Action Items:**

Currently, there are no immediate actions for the board to take. Staff recommends that the Village Board consider the option above and this topic be discussed again at the November 3, 2021, Committee of the Whole. If the board members have any follow up questions during the month of October staff would be glad to coordinate a list of questions and answers for discussion at the November Committee of the Whole.

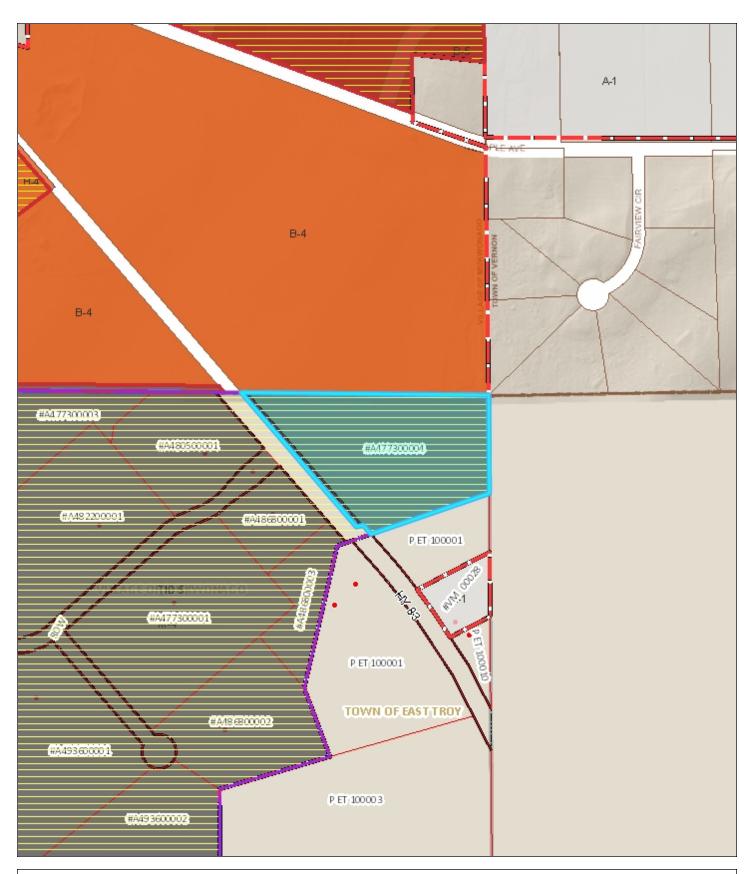

### **ACCESS and INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

This Agreement is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2021, by and between the VILLAGE OF MUKWONAGO, a Wisconsin municipal corporation, with its principal office and place of business located at 440 River Crest Court, Mukwonago, Wisconsin, 53149 (hereinafter referred to as the "Grantor") and BIELINSKI, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee").

WHEREAS, Grantor is the owner of a storm sewer in the Fairwinds Subdivision, which storm sewer runs in the public storm water easement for the Fairwinds Subdivision, south of Lots 108, 109 and 110; and

WHEREAS, Grantee is developing Lots 108 and 109 for the construction of single-family homes; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee is desirous of connecting storm water discharge from the homes to be constructed on Lots 108 and 109 to the Grantor's storm sewer as depicted on the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Village is willing to allow the Grantee to tap into the storm sewer line, provided all of the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Exhibit B are followed, along with those set forth on the Site Plan (Exhibit A) also attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the allowance of Grantee to tap into the storm sewer lines are subject to that being permitted under the terms of the easement itself.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, including, but not limited to, the permission granted by the Grantor to the Grantee, the parties do hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. That the storm sewer running from each residence on Lots 108 and 109 to the Grantor's storm sewer main shall be the responsibility of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, to maintain. In addition, the Grantee shall agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Village of Mukwonago against all claims, demands, actions or causes of action, costs or expenses, including actual attorney fees, arising from any backup which may occur in the storm/sewer laterals shows in Exhibit A, including, but not limited to, any flooding which may occur as a result of said backups.
- 2. The connection to the storm sewer main shall be done only with the approval of the Grantor, according to the Grantor's performance standards for tap-ins to the storm sewer main. The Grantee agrees to abide by the conditions and terms set forth on Exhibit B.
- 3. The Grantee is hereby granted the ability to enter the easement, against subject to its terms, for the purpose of maintaining the storm water lateral and to make connection with the Grantor's storm sewer.

- 4. The Grantee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Grantor as and against any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of action, including costs and actual attorney fees, arising from unpaid liens or from claims arising from injury or damage to property during the course of the installation of the storm sewer lateral and the connection to the Grantor's storm sewer main.
- 5. The Grantor or its contractors shall maintain public liability insurance with limits not less than \$1 Million per occurrence and \$2 Million in aggregate, which insurance shall name the Village of Mukwonago as an Additional Insured on a primary and non-contributory basis.
- 6. The Grantee acknowledges that the Grantor may need to perform maintenance work on its storm sewer within the easement area, and that the storm water lateral may be impacted as part of that work. Grantee consents to the Grantor performing said work. The Grantee shall be responsible for repair of any damage that might be caused as a result of the performance of said work, including, but not limited to, any storm sewer lateral backup.
- 7. This Agreement shall commence upon execution and shall continue to as to allow the Grantee to maintain and, if necessary, replace the storm water lateral within said easement.
- 8. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

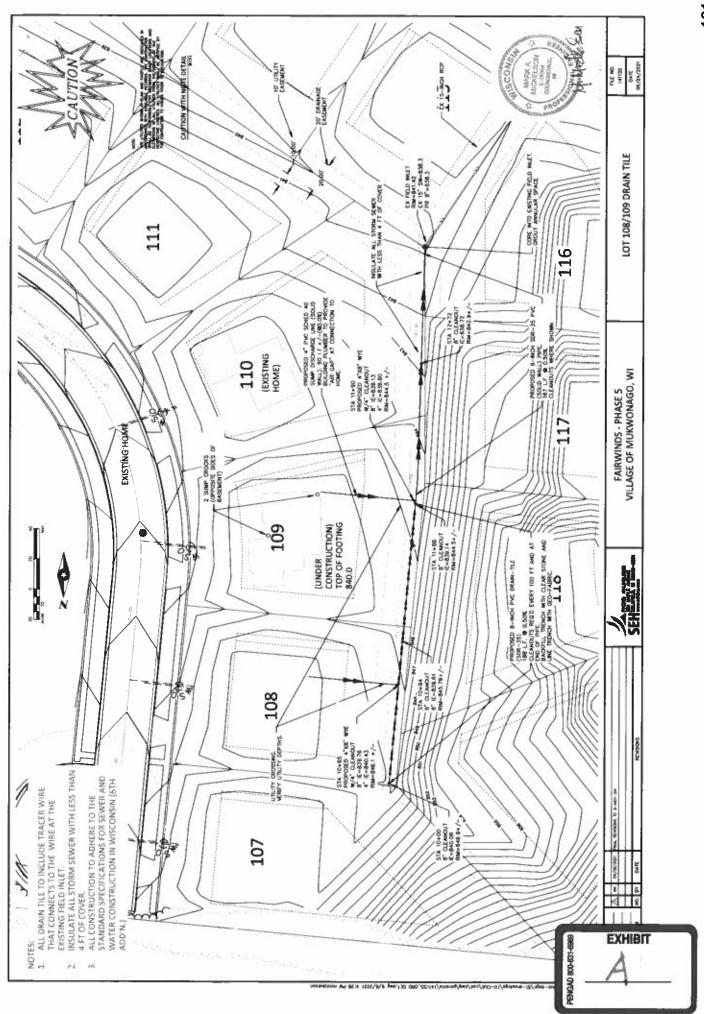

### **EXHIBIT B**

- 1. An air-gap shall be provided at the sump pump discharge point on the immediate exterior of each house on Lot 108 and Lot 109 and shall be approved by the Village of Mukwonago prior to occupancy.
- 2. All pipes and cleanouts shall have tracer wire connected to the exiting wire at the downstream field inlet.
- 3. Prior to occupancy, an as-built of the installed pipes and cleanouts shall be provided to the Village of Mukwonago.
- 4. Prior to occupancy, an as-built of the regraded swale in the drainage easement shall be provided to the Village of Mukwonago such that the Village may be sure the swale was restored to approved plan conditions and does not negatively impact properties downstream.
- 5. The Grantee acknowledges that the Grantor is not responsible for maintaining the lateral pipe and that should it become blocked, the Grantor has no ability to jet the pipe due to its size.
