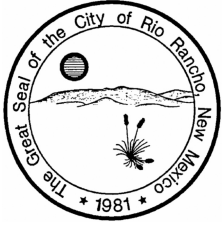

Rio Rancho Arts Commission 2023 Governing Body Report

- Commissioners focused on planning the use of the City's 2022 Capital Improvement Bonds, 1% for the Arts funds with continued improvements at Campus Park
- A Subcommittee continued to develop the City of Rio Rancho Art Resource Guide
 - With images, locations and descriptions of each piece of artwork in the City's collection

Campus Park Improvements

- FY2020 and FY2022 Capital Improvement Bonds, 1% for the Arts funds constructed a unique structure tied to the performance space in Phase 2 of the park



- The remainder of the City's FY2022 Capital Improvement Bonds, 1% for the Arts funds will be used to Create an Artistic Sense of Place at the park following a Public (City) Call For Artists for
 - Main Entryway Feature
 - Sculptures placed throughout Campus Park

New Artwork Added to City Collection Through State Art In Public Places

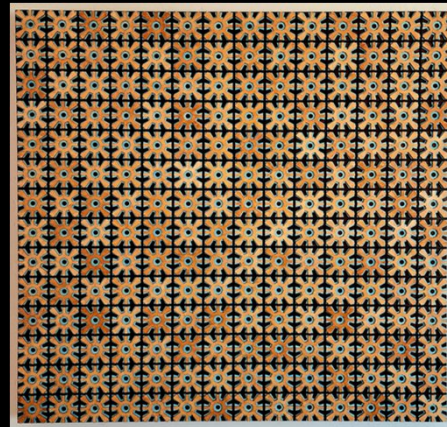
- Grant funding for Sports Complex North improvements had a 1% Art In Public Places requirement

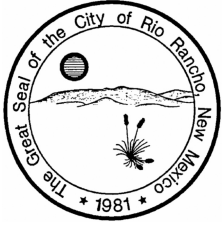
