Bio of Nadine Egan Floyd

Artist Nadine Egan Floyd has worked in oils, acrylic, pastels and other genres, her artistic career has afforded her the opportunity to work in various mediums. She has concentrated a greater portion of her time working in stained glass, mosaic glass, as well as, creating portraits for pets-dogs, cats and most specifically horses.

Since leaving her position as President of The Media Lab, Inc., a video production studio located in the city of Sunrise of 40 years, she has time to pursue her love of art. Her Gators at Sawgrass Mills Mall in Sunrise, Florida, are still there from her original 2010 “Gaudi Gator” covered in stained glass mosaics, along with the Teacher Appreciation Gator, Santa Gator and the NOSD Gator. Another mosaic piece, a Sailfish, is located in Esplanade Park in Downtown Fort Lauderdale, a ceiling with various tropical fish in mosaics in Sadkin Community Center, Lauderhill as well as a mosaic piece at the Pace for Girls in Oakland Park.

Also, many commissions of paintings, glass, fused glass and mosaics.

Nadine majored in fine arts at New Jersey City University, she has won many awards and participated in many juried shows. She is a member of Bonnet House Fine Artists. She has donated to many silent auctions and shares her art as well as her time.

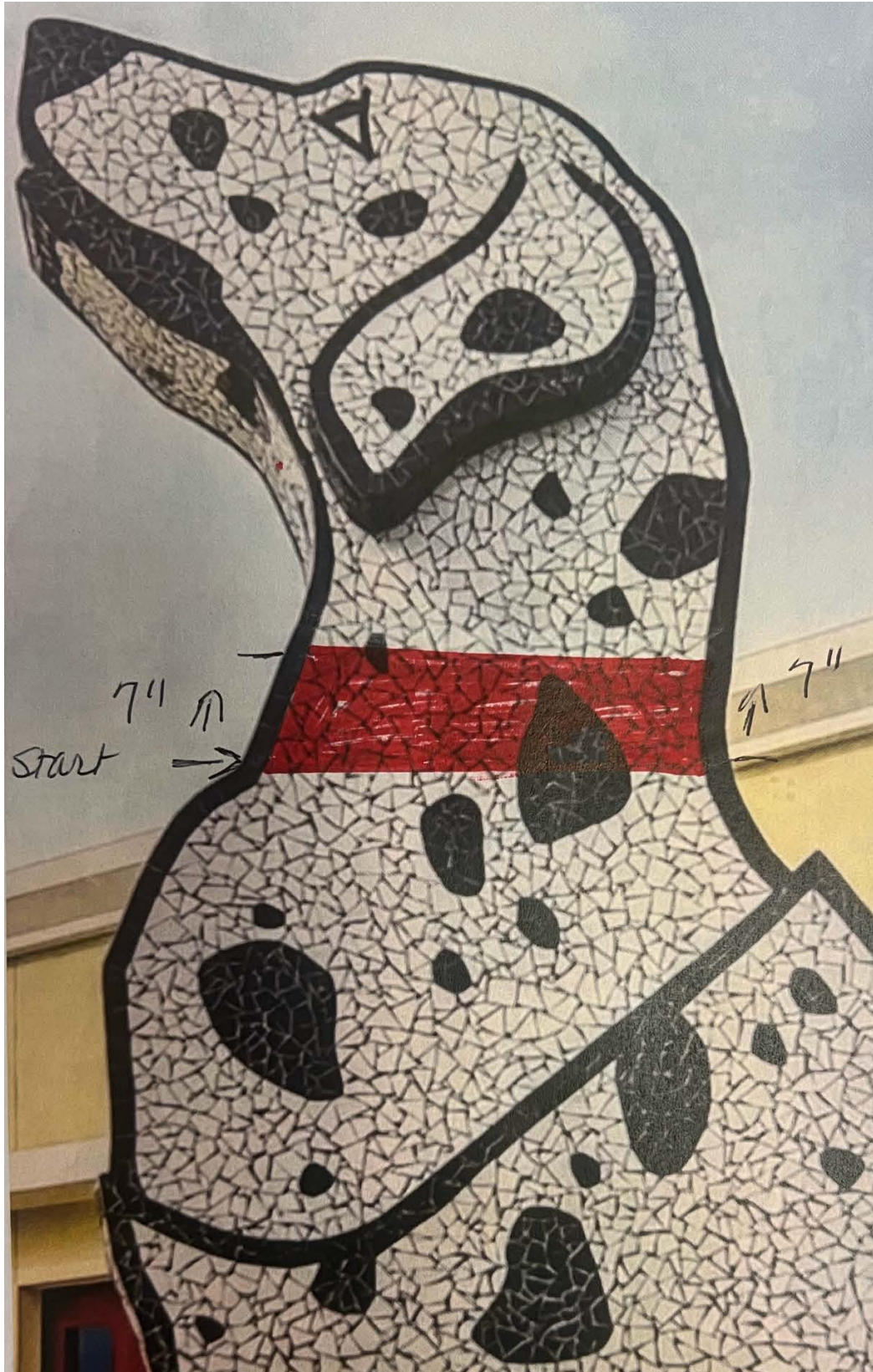
Design Concept

The art design will be a mosaic stained glass collar with a bone shaped id tag made of metal. The name on the tag will be "Speckles McFreckles". This will all be placed on the existing mosaic dalmation art installation located at Firehouse 36.

The collar will be created using red stained glass mosaics for the entire circle around the neck, grout in between the glass will be black. The front will have the brass metal bone shaped id with the dog's name etched in black. Pending final measurements of the existing installation, the collar will be 7" wide.
