The committee reviewed the criteria for disconnection according to Illinois state law.

Weed Killing update

The Village reached out to our Cook County Board Commissioner. Several roads in the village under Cook County jurisdiction, including Brinker, have severe 'brown-out' due to excess herbicide application to control vegetation. The Village is concerned about what chemicals may be used by Cook County within our village for this control. Barrington Hills is concerned about potential groundwater contamination by the herbicides. Administrator Paul is following up.

Water Testing

Annual BACOG water testing event will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019. The week before, you can purchase a kit at the Village Hall and then drop samples off at The Garlands on November 5th. Results will be sent to you in the mail.

Prescription Drug Take Back Program

Prescription drugs can also be dropped off at The Garlands on November 5, 2019. Drugs should not be disposed of in septic systems or in garbage.
